PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Marldon Hard Wax Oil is a professional quick drying clear Hard Wax Oil available in both Clear Satin and Ultra Matt sheen levels to suit your desired finish, the oil penetrates deeply into the surface. Protecting in a natural way ensures long durability and beauty of the wood and its surface. It is colourless (clear) when dry and produces no odour when cured.

Contrary to other Hard Wax Oils Marldon Hard Wax Oil is quick-drying (taking only 3 – 4 hrs in comparison with the customary 8-10 hrs drying time), you can apply the second final coat on the same day!

PREPARATION

For the treatment of unfinished/ completely sanded wood flooring.

Remove all sanding dust. The surface must be clean, dry and free from all contaminants that may effect adhesion and have a recommended moisture content of less than 12% (max. humidity 18%).

Ideal application temperatures are between 15°c to 25°c.

Shake the tin well for 3-4 minutes before use, stir well once opened. Marldon Hard Wax Oil is supplied ready to use, so there is no need for dilution.

A coloured surface can be produced by using Marldon Colour Wax Oil for the first coat. The final coat will be Marldon Hard Wax Oil.

For re coating, on previously oiled surfaces, (which must not have word down to bare timber) a test is to be done in a inconspicuous area of the floor to test the compatibility of the two products.

All traces of polish and previous cleaning substances must be removed and the floor may be slightly abraded if neccessary. One coat will usually be sufficient.

For re application on Marldon Hard Wax oiled surfaces, no test needs to be done.

PRIMING

No priming is needed prior to using this product.

For exotic hardwoods such as Mahogany, Wenge, Merbau, Jatoba, Marldon Hard Wax oil intense is recommended for the first coat as it penetrates more easily into the surface. Leave to dry for 8 hrs.

APPLICATION

For ideal working conditions the oil and room temperature must be between 15°C (59°F) and 25°C (77°F). RH (Relative Humidity) between 40% and 60%.

For application on furniture use either a Marldon Applicator Brush or lint-free cloth. For application on flat surfaces such as flooring, we recommend using a Marldon Hard Wax Oil Roller or Marldon Applicator Brush (220mm).

Do not pour Marldon Hard Wax Oil directly on the surface. Instead, we recommend using a paint/applicator tray.

Apply a first coat evenly and thinly along the wood grain - drying time for the first coat is 3-4 hours. Please note that drying time is dependent upon conditions within the work area.

The surface will be dust-dry after approx. 2 hours.

Marldon Hard Wax Oil is oxidative drying, please provide adequate ventilation throughout and following application.

For newly sanded or untreated timber, two coats should be applied. The second coat will take longer to dry than the first, allow 3-5 hours, ideally leave overnight. On the second coat it is possible to remove excess material with the use of a slow speed buffing machine, nylon pads and lint free oil cloths, this produces a flaw free smooth natural looking finish.

It is sometimes the manufacturers recommendation for the addition of a site applied coat of Hard Wax Oil on naturally oiled pre finished floors. This gives the floor an additional level of protection to ensure it can withstand high levels of foot traffic. For this particular application, we recommend that the oil is applied evenly and thinly as described above, left to penetrate in to the surface of the timber for 20-30 minutes, then the excess oil removed with the use of a slow speed buffing machine, nylon pads and lint free oil cloths. This produces a smooth even finish to the floor and eliminates the chances of patchiness on the finished surface.

For renovation, on previously oiled surfaces a test is to be done in a inconspicuous area of the floor to test the compatibility of the two products. One coat will usually be sufficient.

For re-application on Marldon Hard Wax oiled surfaces, no test needs to be done.

HEALTH & ENVIRONMENT

Clean all brushes and application tools with a solvent based brush cleaner - make sure that you clean them before the oil has completely dried.
