1. SAFETY

- Regularly inspect the water butt and it's fittings for damage or wear. If necessary, immediately repair or replace damaged parts.
- Place water butt on level and solid ground, preferably concrete to ensure it is well balanced and unlikely to topple.
- **DO NOT** modify water butt in any way. **DO NOT** use the water butt for any other purpose other than that for which it was designed.

2. INTRODUCTION

250ltr Capacity water barrel for collecting rain water from a rooftop gutter. Durable corrosion-resistant PVC cover. Includes six standing poles, fitted with adjustable feet to provide good stability. Effortless installation with no tools needed. Zipped lid fitted at the top to keep the water clean after collection. Installed with an overflow pipe which can accommodate a hose to direct the overflow. Water tank is fitted with a drain tap, thread filter, 3/4" ABS outlet valve, 1/2" thread insert, thread plug and overflow/inlet fitting. Overall tank size: Ø60 x 88cm.

5. ASSEMBLY

5.1. LOWER DRAIN

- 5.1.1. Screw hose connector (fig.5) into drain body (fig.2)
- 5.1.2. Screw drain filter (fig.6) into other end of drain body with the filter section innermost and use a rubber washer (fig.3) between mating faces.
- 5.1.3. Pass drain filter male threaded section (fig.6) through lower hole into butt and secure in place using an internal filter (fig.7). Use rubber washers (fig.3) either side of the butt wall to ensure a leak proof seal.

5.2. TAP FITTING

5.2.1. Pass male threaded spigot of tap (fig.1) through butt side wall hole and secure in place using an internal filter (fig.7). Use rubber washers (fig.3) either side of the butt wall to ensure a leak proof seal.

5.3. OVERFLOW

5.3.1. Pass male threaded spigot of overflow (fig.8) through butt side wall hole and secure in place using an internal filter (fig.7). Use rubber washers (3) either side of the butt wall to ensure a leak proof seal.

5.4. SUPPORTS

5.5. Push feet (fig.4) onto tubular legs (fig.9) and slide into pockets on the outside of water butt from the bottom up. Ensure full length engagement.

6. OPERATION

- 6.1. If required, fit hose onto the overflow fitting (fig.8) and direct output as required (hose not supplied).
- 6.2. Once a suitable location for the butt is determined pour a small amount of water into it in order to stabilise it.

7. MAINTENANCE

- 7.1. Dry thoroughly before storing for any period of time.
- 7.2. Check fittings and materials regularly for any leaks or damage.
- 7.3. Store in frost free environment.
