1. SAFETY

2. INTRODUCTION

Versatile stand suitable for a wide variety of body shop applications. Work height is fully adjustable by lengthening chains. Foam cushioned supports help prevent marking panel.

3. SPECIFICATION

4. ASSEMBLY

Refer to parts list.

- 4.1. Push rubber feet on to ends of legs as shown.
- 4.2. Slide legs fig.1.1 into panel supports fig.1.2 and fix using hook bolts fig.1.3 as shown.
- 4.3. Bolt the two halves of the stand together using the bolts / nuts / washers supplied. Ensure hooks face inwards.
- 4.4. Suspend the chains between the hooks as shown to obtain required height.
- 4.5. Panel stand can be folded up when not in use for ease of storage.
- WARNING! Take care not to trap fingers.
