1. SAFETY

- ✓ Locate storage system in a suitable area where they will not be an obstruction.
- ✓ Keep the general area clean, uncluttered and ensure there is adequate lighting.
- ☐ **WARNING!** Erect storage system on a level and solid surface such as concrete.
- ✓ Keep children and unauthorised persons away from the storage area.

2. INTRODUCTION

Fixing kit allows multiple units to be joined together. Compatible with TPS22 and TPS36 to make TPS44 and TPS72.

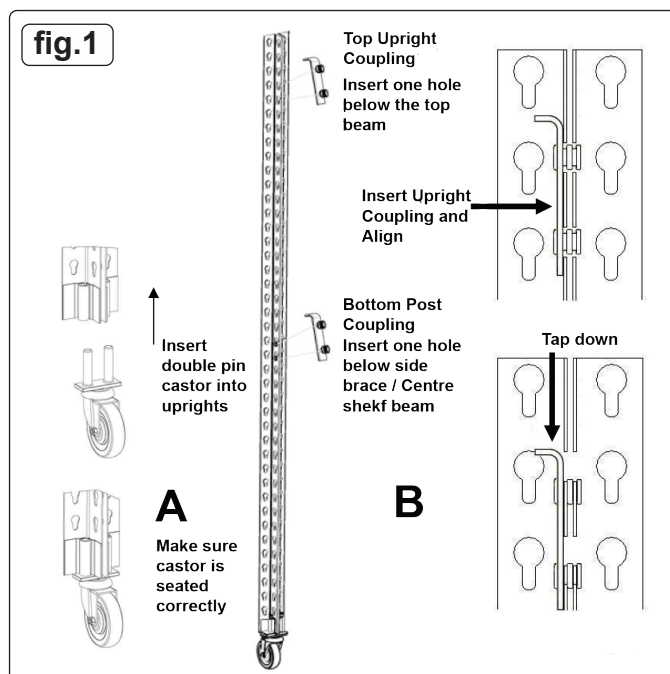
3. CONTENTS

Double pin castor x2
Upright coupling x4

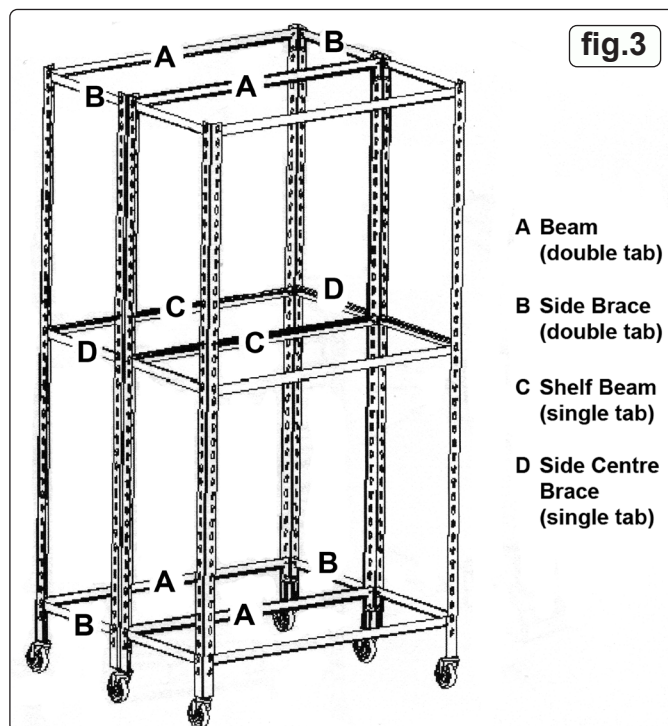
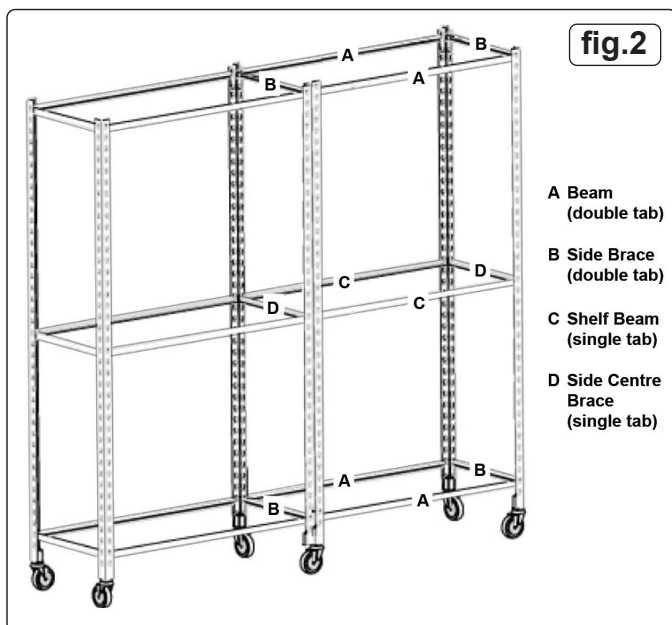


4. ASSEMBLY

- 4.1. Two people will be needed to assemble the additional storage system. Part disassembly of the original unit will also be necessary.
- 4.2. **ASSEMBLE THE DOUBLE UPRIGHTS - TPS72 ONLY**
- 4.2.1. Take the frames already made and remove the castor from the right hand side (front and back) and replace with a double pin castors from the joining kit.
- 4.2.2. Install two of the upright couplings on each double upright in the hole specified as per Fig.1B, this will lock the uprights together.
- 4.2.3. Tap the coupling down with a soft faced mallet.
- 4.2.4. Repeat for second frame.



- 4.3. Using the double uprights as a start point, build up the other half to the storage system. Use Fig.4 or Fig.5 for reference and follow from section 4.2. from TPS22, TPS36 instructions.



- 4.4. **BACK TO BACK CONFIGURATION** - This manual has described how to build this storage system side by side but its possible to build with each unit back to back.
- 4.4.1. To do this build the storage system as described but instead of putting the double uprights on the right short side of the frame configure to the long back side of the frame.
- 4.4.2. Then build up as Fig.3 and install the rest of the shelf beams.
- 4.4.3. Finally place wire shelves onto frame starting with the shelf for the larger bins at the bottom and working up.
- 4.4.4. Follow from section 4.2. TPS22, TPS36 instructions.
