2. INTRODUCTION


An essential race-day tool. Compact design ensures accurate drilling of nuts and bolts. Supplied in a pouch.

3. SPECIFICATION

 $M6 \times 1$, $M8 \times 1$, $M8 \times 1.25$, $M10 \times 1.25$, $M10 \times 1.5$, $M12 \times 1.5$ mm

4. OPERATION

- **DO NOT hand-hold**; Always mount in a vice or clamp to pillar drill table.
- **4.1.** Screw bolt into bolt jig until shank is past the cross shaft.(See Fig.1)
- **4.2.** Apply a 1.5mm drill to the smaller end of the cross shaft and drill through the bolt.
- **4.3.** Similarly, clamp nut into nut jig (see Fig.2) and drill through the jig from the smaller end of the cross shaft using a 1.5mm drill. This will pierce the corner of the nut allowing a safety wire to be inserted.
