1. SAFETY

- ✓ Maintain the tool in a good, clean condition for the best and safest performance.
- ✓ If required, ensure that the vehicle to be worked on is adequately supported with axle stands or ramps and is chocked.
- ✓ Put transmission in PARK (automatic transmission) or NEUTRAL (manual transmission) and make sure the parking brake is engaged.
- √ Wear approved eye protection. A full range of personal safety equipment is available from your Sealey dealer.
- ✓ Wear suitable clothing to avoid snagging. Do not wear jewellery and tie back long hair.

2. INTRODUCTION

Essential tool for extinguishing the Particulate Filter light after the filter has been replaced. Also resets the ELOYS additive after it has been topped up and burns any particles that have clogged the filters (regenerate). Powered by connection to the vehicle.

3. FEATURES

The VS8626 tool:


- 3.1. Is compatible with the latest CAN vehicles.
- 3.2. Enables Fuel Additive functions for Replacing Filters, resetting
- 3.3. Additive Reset lights and performing the Regenerate Process.


The new VS8626 Peugeot / Citroen Particulate tool has been designed to extinguish the Particulate Filter Light after the filter has been replaced, re-set the ELOYS additive light after it has been topped up and also burn any particles that have clogged the filter (regenerate).



4. OPERATION

- 4.1. Filter Replace –This is a light on the dashboard that is illuminated when the filter is clogged and needs changing, or potentially regenerating.
- 4.2. Additive Reset This is a light on the dashboard that is illuminated when the fuel additive is empty or low and needs refilling.
- 4.3. Regenerate Filter This will increase the engine speed to around 4000 RPM, which in turn will increase the temperature of the exhaust gases; this causes the soot that has built up on the filter to be burnt off.








4.4. Vehicle Set-Up


- 4.4.1. Ensure that the vehicle is parked outside, on a non-flammable surface and away from any combustibles (the exhaust system could reach temperatures above 300°C). That it's engine is at working temperature, with at least a ¼ tank of fuel and that there are no fault codes stored.
- 4.4.2. Ensure that the vehicle's ignition is turned off.
- 4.4.3. Connect the tool to the correct diagnostic socket on the vehicle, refer to the vehicle owner's manual for it's location.
- 4.4.4. Turn on the vehicle's ignition.

Note: As part of the process, a clear codes message will be sent to the vehicle (any faults that are permanent on the vehicle will remain until the fault is fixed).




4.5. Filter Replace

- 4.5.1. Press the Function button to select the appropriate system. (There is a full list of systems on the rear of the tool).
- 4.5.2. Press Mode button to select correct type (Filter Replace).
- 4.5.3. Press the 'OK' button to perform the function.
- 4.5.4. Once the function has completed, the Mode LED will flash to indicate a successful reset.
- 4.5.5. If the function is unsuccessful, the 3 System Selection LEDs will flash.



4.6. Additive Reset

- 4.6.1. Press the Function button to select the appropriate system. (There is a full list of systems on the rear of the tool).
- 4.6.2. Press Mode button to select correct type (Additive Reset).
- 4.6.3. Press the 'OK' button to perform the function.
- 4.6.4. Once the function has completed, the Mode LED will flash to indicate a successful reset.
- 4.6.5. If the function is unsuccessful, the 3 System Selection LEDs will flash.
- 4.6.6. Disconnect tester, open filler cap for more than 5 seconds, then close again.



4.7. Regenerate Filter

- 4.7.1. Start the vehicle's engine and allow it to warm up.
- 4.7.2. Press the Function button to select the appropriate system. (There is a full list of systems on the rear of the tool).
- 4.7.3. Press Mode button to select correct type (Regenerate Filter).
- 4.7.4. Press the 'OK' button to perform the function.
- 4.7.5. Once the function has completed, the Mode LED will flash to indicate a successful reset.
- 4.7.6. If the function is unsuccessful, the 3 System Selection LEDs will flash.
- 4.7.7. Switch the ignition off, unplug the tool and turn ignition on.

NOTE: Regeneration takes around 15 mins in total (2 mins running at idle, 8 mins at 4000rpm and then 5 mins at idle). Ensure that rear / exhaust area of the vehicle is kept clear of people for this period.
